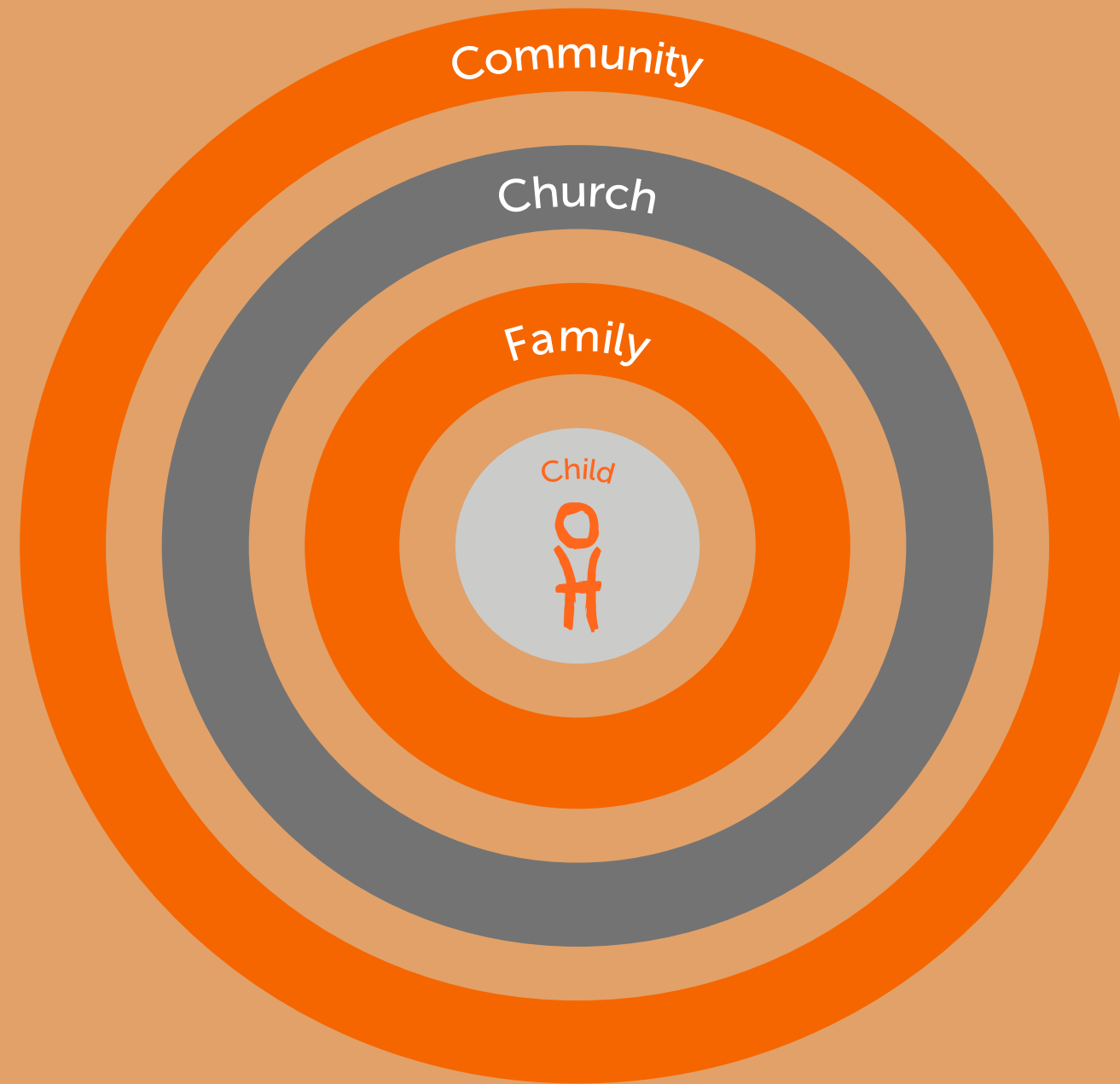
The Connecting Church

What types of transactions are restricted?

- ATM cash withdrawals
- Peer-to-peer cash transfers (CashApp, Venmo, etc.)

Quick Tip: If your church needs to use funds from your CarePortal Card to perform one of these transactions, you can make a donation from your CarePortal card to your church and perform the transaction through your church's banking provider.

Funding Left on the Card

What should be done with money left over on the card after we've met the need?

- Meet additional open requests through CarePortal in the community.

Can my church refund money to a donor if things don't work out?

- Yes!

Multiple CarePortal Cards

Additional cards can be ordered by the Primary Point Person for other designated connecting church leaders within the church.

Note: All cards are connected to the same card balance.

Taking the Lead

Commit & Claim

- Being the "lead church"
 - All community responses for remaining items on the request (if there are any) will be sent your way to combine and coordinate.

Inappropriate Use

- Receiving funds and then using other resources to meet the need (funds should be returned)
- Receiving funds on your CarePortal Card and not providing the items you've committed to
- Using leftover card funds for items or services unrelated to CarePortal requests
- Providing non-reliable or defective items

Practically Speaking

- Requests may be closed early
 - Track requests you are meeting outside of CarePortal
- Have a system in place in order to provide for rent needs and others that would require a check. Or only meet needs that can utilize debit/credit card payment.
- Make sure your card number is never saved in any system.
- Ways to avoid gift cards: fill a gas tank, purchase groceries
